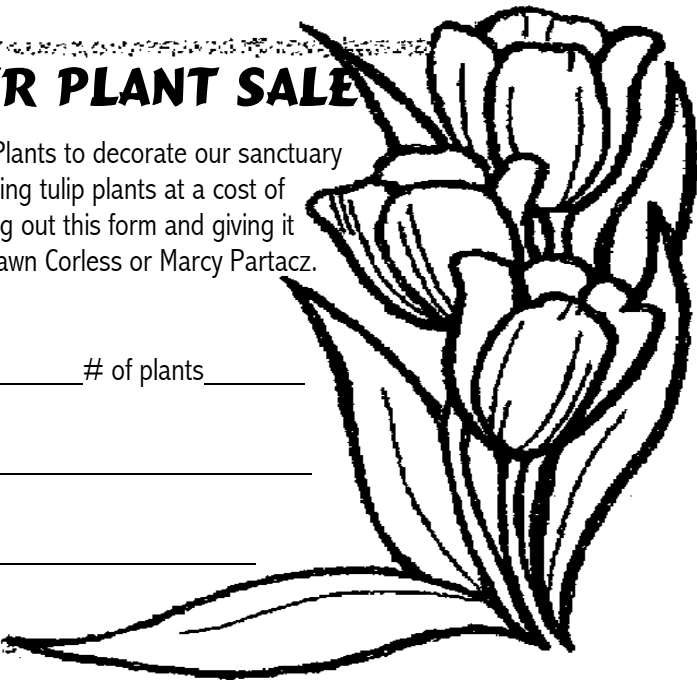
EASTER PLANT SALE
