COMMUNION SERVICE

Pastor: Mighty and loving God: We thank you for the gift of life, and for the world our home. We thank you for your loving kindness to us and all people. Your works are great and wonderful. Your ways are just and true. You alone are holy.
Holy God: We praise you for your Son Jesus, who shared our weakness, and was tempted in every way as we are; who obeyed you, suffering and dying for us. You have raised him to rule the world, and given him a name above every name – Lord and Christ. We praise him and we glorify you, our God, who sent Jesus as a servant to wash away our pride, and to feed us with the bread of life. We thank you for inviting us to feast with him who died for us, and who teaches us to serve each other in modesty and love.
Now give us your Spirit in the breaking of bread, so that by your power we may be drawn together and made one with Jesus Christ, who is the way, and the truth, and the life.

People: With Christians through all ages, we lift our hearts to you, giving thanks, and trusting you to use us as your people; for the sake of Jesus Christ our Savior, who taught us to pray saying:

*all who are able may stand

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory, forever. Amen.

Pastor: The Lord Jesus, on the night of his arrest, took bread, and after giving thanks to God, broke it and said: "This is my body which is for you; do this remembering me." In the same way, Jesus took the cup after supper, and said: "This cup is the new covenant sealed in my blood. Whenever you drink it, do this remembering me." For every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until He comes.
