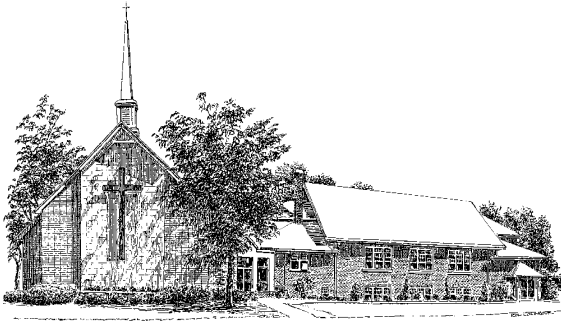

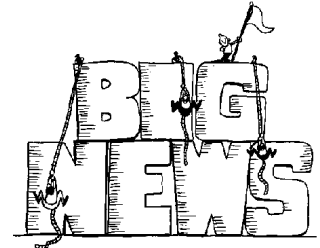

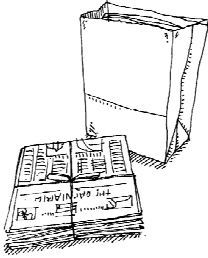

## Recycling Goal for May 2008 - August 2008



Welcome to the What's Your Goal program! If we, First Presbyterian Church, can meet one of the following goals, Cornerstone Manor will receive extra money. All we need to do is recycle more paper than we did last year! If we recycle a total of **18.3 tons (36,600 lbs.)** during the 4 months (May 2008 - August 2008) of the program period, Cornerstone Manor will earn an extra \$250 and if we recycle a total of **19.06 tons (38,120 lbs.)**,

Cornerstone Manor will earn an extra \$500.

We can do this by recycling one extra bag of papers once a month. This will get us to our \$250 goal. If you recycle two extra bags during a month we will get to the \$500 goal. Please ask at work, friends, neighbors, and relatives for their bags of paper, junk mail, and old newspapers. I will keep us updated in the Sunday bulletins so keep an eye out for on how we are doing.

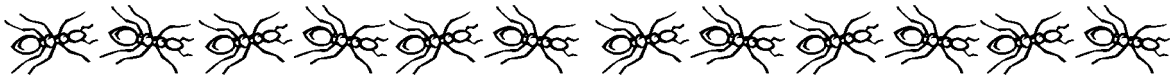

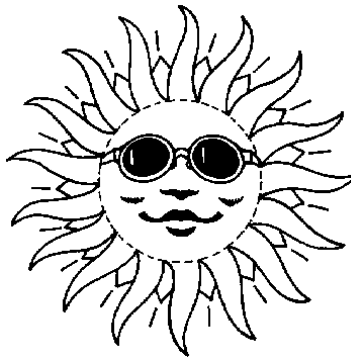
